This AKC Scent Work Trial is being held in conjunction with the 2019 ESSFTA National Specialty Show. National Obedience and Conformation Events will be going on at Pala Mesa on the same day as the Scent Work trial. Any Scent Work competitor with a potential conflict should make it known to the Scent Work Trial secretary as soon as possible. All reasonable efforts will be made to assure your searches are completed in time for you to prepare for your other events, but once a scent work class has been completed, and the judge has moved on to her next class, it will not be reset later in the day to accommodate conflicts. DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

ENTRIES RECEIVED BEFORE OPENING DATE WILL BE RETURNED!

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Lori Brison at loribscntwork@gmail.com. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are eligible for a 50% refund. Owner must provide a note from their veterinarian no later than 24 hours before the trial starts.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day.

MOVE-UP INFORMATION

All pre-trial move-ups must be received by 9pm PDT, Monday, October 7, 2019. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. Please send an email to loribscntwork@gmail.com to request your move-up.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

The English Springer Spaniel Field Trial Association is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries will be placed on the waitlist. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after the closing date unless it is replaced by a wait listed entry. Only then, will a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

CONDITIONS AND SEARCH AREAS

Search areas may be of any shape, and size specified in the Regulations for each class. Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, asphalt, and on uneven surfaces. Trial will take place rain or shine.

RIBBONS - Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place Blue Third Place Yellow
Second Place Red Fourth Place White
Qualifying Score Dark Green

Separate Placement ribbons will also be offered to English Springer Spaniels only.

New Title Ribbons will be available to teams finishing a title at this trial.

High in Trial

Novice, Advanced, Excellent and Master High In Trial Rosettes will be offered at this trial. *Separate Novice, Advanced, Excellent and Master High In Trial Rosettes, along with a Pewter Trophy will also be offered to English Springer Spaniels only at this trial.*

Only teams who participate and qualify, in the same difficulty level of all elements offered for that level (Container, Interior, Exterior, and Buried) are eligible for High in Trial. There is no separate High in Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections; they are combined. The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times will be summed, and the faster finishing team will win.

SITE INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The Handler's Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A Warm-up Area will be available consisting of ONE marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and will also consist of blanks containers. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior their run. The warm-up area is not for training.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Crating will be in a designated area on the driving range - Provide your own shade. ESSFTA will be providing a canopy for crating Springers only entered in the National Performance events.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. English Springer Spaniel Field Trial Association, Inc and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. English Springer Spaniel Field Trial Association, Inc reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the English Springer Spaniel Field Trial Association, Inc or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is NOT appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

ESS Handlers will be sent a preliminary confirmation once your entry is received. Non ESS Handlers will start receiving confirmations after the priority period has ended. Final confirmations with trial details will be sent about one week before the trial.

Entering Novice A or B: The Novice A class is for beginner dogs. The Novice B class is for dogs who have earned a title in that element (in AKC or in another organization), for Scent Work Judges and handlers who have worked as professional detection dog handlers. The exhibitor is responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es). Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

NOTE: Dogs may enter up to **two** different difficulty levels of each element at the same trial, as long as they are eligible to enter each level. **Examples:** Dogs may enter Novice B Container and Advanced Container – they must have earned the Novice Container Title. Dogs may enter Advanced Exterior and Excellent Exterior – they must have earned the Advanced Exterior Title.
