 Club signs/orange flags will be prominently displayed to the hunt test grounds.

No training of dogs is permitted on the grounds the days of the tests. Please
 keep your dog(s) on lead or crated when not being tested.

Blaze orange clothing is required by all people in the field during land and water
 work.

Smoking is NOT allowed in the fields.

Standard AKC rosettes awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

Lunch will be available both days for a nominal fee.
